New business

Treasurer's Report

- Sue presented the yearend report. All monies allocated were spent as designated.
- Allstate grant
 - The funds are listed in the general fund now until they are distributed between the allocated programs.
 - \$5000.00 has been allocated to assist start-up of a teen driving program In Eastern Weld County. Drive Smart will control where the money is spent. Kristi is meeting with the school today.
 - Sue reviewed the items listed for purchase. Randy and Lisa will investigate a portable screen to use in schools that don't have a screen larger than 6 foot.
 - Travis suggested buying an ipad for the grand prize at Tailgate.
 - It was suggested to fund the printing of t-shirts for students that are participating in the Act Out Loud program. There are 2 students confirmed and may be a third. Enough shirts would be printed for the team that is working on the project.
 - Drive Smart was awarded a \$10,000 grant from State Farm. Approximately \$2000.00 of this money will go into the general fund with the rest being allocated to P.A.R.T.Y., Tailgate and Parent of Teen activities.
 - Marjorie will work on replicating the texting banner design in order to save money on purchasing.
